ELIGIBILITY: All graduating high school seniors, who are **RELATED** to an Illinois Jaycee or Illinois JCI Senator that reside in Illinois, who will be enrolling in their first year of full-time study at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational school.

SPONSORSHIP: Your sponsor is a member of the Illinois Jaycees or Illinois JCI Senator to whom you are **RELATED** (child/stepchild, grandchild, brother, sister, niece, nephew). Your sponsor is required to attach a letter to your application per the application instructions. If you are related to more than one member of the Illinois Jaycees or JCI Senator, they may sign a joint letter.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD: Recipients are based upon involvement, leadership roles, honors and awards, volunteer community service, employment, personal statements, financial statement, scholastic achievement and sponsor letter. Specific questions can be found on the application. Judging is done by an independent group with recipients being notified no later than April 15.

RESTRICTION: Applicants who have won an Illinois Jaycee Charitable Foundation Scholarship are not eligible for this award.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- All submissions must be typewritten or printed.
- Complete the first page of application and include as your first page of application.
- No more than four (4) sheets of paper may be used to answer questions II. VII.
- All applications should be completed in the order listed on the application and reference your responses to the outline identification headings and characters.
- All applications must be received by **MARCH 1st** to be considered.

All letters are a maximum of one page.

IX. TRANSCRIPT

An official copy of your current high school transcript <u>MUST</u> be included. Transcript should indicate class rank (if your school includes it on the transcript), current academic average (minimum of 7 semesters) and any ACT/SAT scores. If your school will only provide the transcript in a sealed envelope, it is okay to open it and include it in the emailed application. However, if your school insists on only providing it to the committee, please have your school email it to <u>bsup62@comcast.net</u>. Follow up to make sure it was received.

X. ACCEPTANCE LETTER

Please attach a copy of your chosen college, university or trade school acceptance letter. If accepted to multiple Colleges/Universities and you are undecided, please include all acceptance letters.
